Three-year project until March 2025

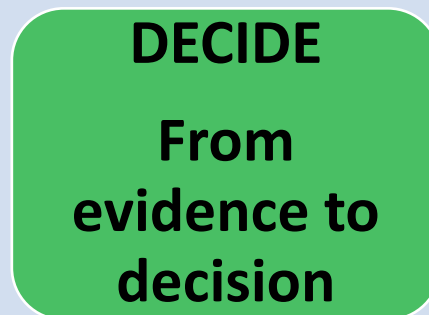
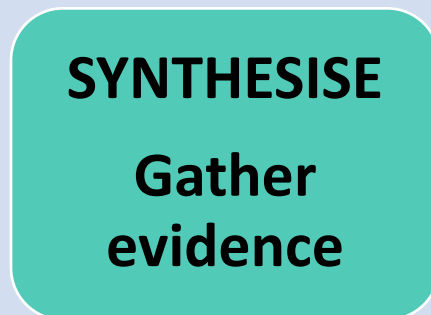
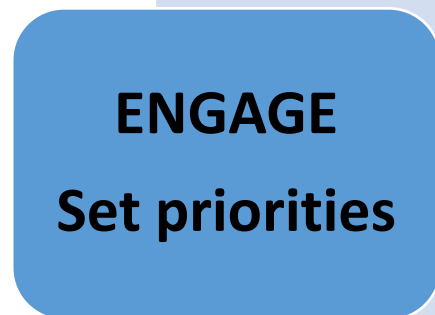
Maximise the impact of evidence use for children and newborns through:

LEARN – guideline panel & methodologists/ researchers, students



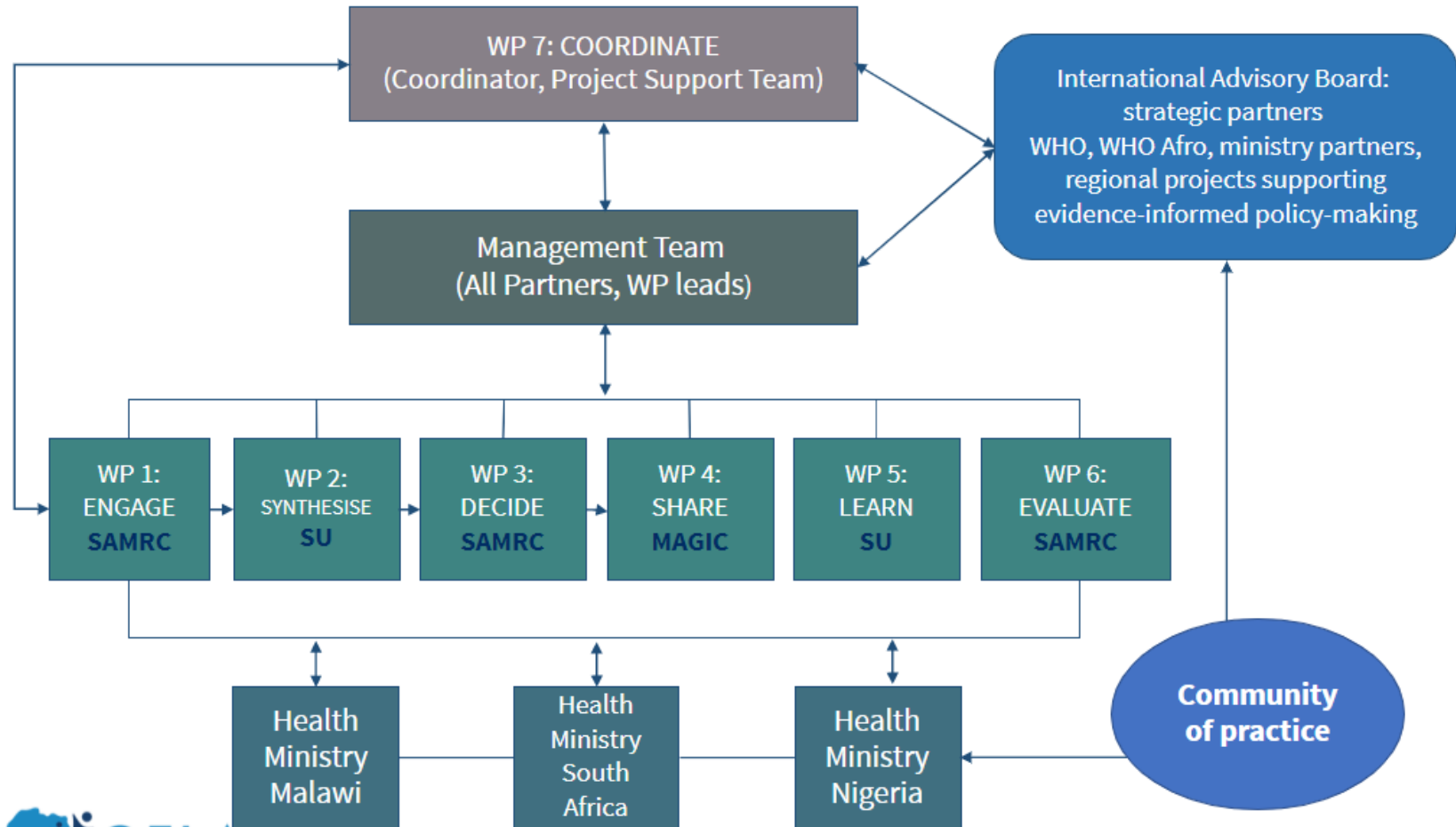
